



CALLISTEMON

Callistemon is a genus to the family Myrtaceae and it is an evergreen shrub originating from Australia and New Caledonia. It has thin, elongated, light-green leaves and at the end of its branches it produces the characteristic cilindrical, brush like red flowers which earned this plant the common nickname of bottlebrush. Actually, the flowers are very small and the visible part is entirely made up of its long, fleshy stamens.
