



## DIPLADENIA

It belongs to the family Apocynaceae, hailing from central and south America. The dipladenia is an evergreen climbing plant with smooth, oval, bright-green leaves. The inflorescences are simple racemes, and each flower has a large, trumped-shaped pink corolla with a yellow center terminated by 5 oval lobes, partially overlapping. Thanks to its extraordinary flexibility and rapid growth it is suited to the most original ornamental habits, such as pyramidal, espalier, double arch, and many more.
