



## PLATYCODON

It belongs to the family Campanulaceae and it originates from Asia. The Platycodon, also known as "Grandiflora bluebell" or "Japanese bluebell", is a perennial shrub that has a thick bush with oval, slightly indented, light green leaves. It produces large, balloon-shaped buds from which blue, white and, rarely, pink flowers bloom. It is characterized by abundant summer flowering and, therefore, it is ideal for ensuring color in the gardens in the least "flowery" periods of the year.
